WARNINGS

- Choose a site with a flat, clean and non abrasive floor.
- Make sure that a security zone is respected.
- For each set up, a visual and manual check of the stability and the solidity of the equipment are mandatory.
- The equipment needs to be secure when being used or made unusable if it's stored.
- The owner needs to maintain the equipment to make sure that it corresponds to the safety requirements.
- · The owner has to make a maintenance check list.
- Make a list with, for each site, the date and the results of each verification.
- Each equipment non conform to the safety requirements needs to be inaccessible to users by the owner or the operator.
- Do not use this equipment for something other than what it is originally made for.
- · Do not hang, climb or swing on this equipment.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning : Use a non nocive detergent (soap and water for example).
- Important : Before any use, replace worn bungee cords or protections.

1 - SETTING UP

Setting up the equipment is very simple. You just need to follow the picture below to place all the elements of the Home Ball® court.



2 - STACKING

Stack a **simple bar** fully into an angle socket and then stack the **junction bars** into it. Stack another angle socket into it and here you go ! Repeat the same process for the four sides.

3 - FOAM PROTECTION INSTALLATION

Install 3 foam protections between each socket with the Velcro.

4 - ANGLE POSTS INSTALLATION

- A Stack a top post into a bottom post (Repeat for each post).
 - For each post :
 - Slide the 5 bungee cords onto the post.
 - Use the link to put the 3 branch-bungee cord and the securing bungee cord in position on top.
- **B** Finally stack the posts in the sockets.

5 - SETTING UP THE NET

STEP 5A : UNFOLD THE NET

Place the net in one angle of the court and unroll it to the opposite angle.

STEP 5B : HANG UP THE NET TO THE SHORTEST AND HIGHEST BUNGEE CORDS

Hang up the 4 top angles of the net to the highest and shortest bungee cords.

STEP 5C : HANG UP THE NET TO THE SHORTEST AND LOWEST BUNGEE CORDS

Once the net is suspended, hang up the 4 lowers angles of the net to the shortest and lowest bungee cords.

STEP 5D : HANG UP THE LONGEST BUNGEE CORDS AND THE SECURING BUNGEE CORDS

Hang up 1 long 3 branch-bungee cord and 1 securing bungee cord with the link in each angle.

STEP 5E : HANG UP THE SHORTEST BUNGEE CORDS

Hang up and spread out the shortest bungee cords on the sides every 10 mesh to tighten the net.
